HARDYS BAY COMMUNITY CLUB COVID-19 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Hardys Bay Community Club has the following conditions of entry to the club in line with COVID-19 regulations to keep patrons, volunteers and staff safe:

- Our total venue capacity is 300 people at any one time.
- The one person per 2sqm rule will apply to indoor and outdoor areas of the Club.
- All patrons must sign in using the Service NSW QR code. This includes providing your name and contact number. Our staff can assist you with this.
- All members and guests must remain seated when inside the Club unless ordering food, beverages or travelling between areas and no cross mingling is permissible.
- Patrons can stand in outside areas but must social distance by 1.5m from other patrons.
- All patrons must keep 1.5m distance between themselves and others when standing outside or queuing for services (unless you are from the same household).
- ❖ Dancing is not permitted anywhere in the Club.
- Please respect and listen to any requests made by our staff and COVID Safety Marshals.
- Any individual that displays symptoms of illness will be directed to leave the Club premises and seek medical advice and undertake a COVID-19 test.

These rules are for the ongoing health and safety of members, guests and staff.
